Specific functions that the successful candidate will have to carry out and type of teaching and scientific requirements

Teaching requirements: the successful candidate must be able to teach courses in the Disciplinary Scientific Sector MED/37 – Neuroradiology – at the University of Molise, with particular reference to Diagnostic Imaging of neoplastic, vascular, traumatic, and degenerative diseases of the brain and spine, as well as of head and neck diseases. The professor will also be involved in mentoring and assisting students, and supervising their BA, MA, PhD, and postgraduate medical theses with reference to the discipline of the sector MED 36 – Diagnostic Imaging and Radiotherapy. The successful candidate must be able to carry out teaching activities at the Medical Postgraduate Specialization School in Radiology as regards the imaging of the nervous system and head and neck diseases, including specific practical training activities.

Scientific requirements: the successful candidate must be able to carry out scientific research activities within the Department with reference to the issues and methods of the Scientific Sector MED/37 – Neuroradiology, with particular reference to vascular, degenerative and neoplastic diseases of the nervous system and head and neck diseases.

Additional aspects of teaching and scientific committments: scientific expertise within the Scientific Sector MED/37 – Neuroradiology, including leadership roles in relevant scientific societies, in order to produce publications in national and international fields with a significant impact factor, and contribute to basic and applied research activities in the Department of Medicine and Health Sciences.

Clinical profile: the candidate must possess professional skills related to Neuroradiology, with particular reference to neoplastic, vascular, traumatic and degenerative diseases of the nervous system in adults and children, and to head and neck diseases.
