Qualitative standards and further qualification elements: several years of high-profile teaching and research activity in the scientific disciplinary sector M-STO/04 CONTEMPORARY HISTORY are required, with a particular focus on the events of the Southern, Italian and European, twentieth century concerning the political, cultural, social and institutional developments.

Teaching activity: The candidate will be required to teach courses in the M-STO/04 CONTEMPORARY HISTORY sector and in similar sectors within the three-years undergraduate programme, master's programme and the doctoral degree at the Department of Economics of the University of Molise and, subordinately, at other Departments of the University of Molise, with particular attention to the political and social history of Southern Italy, investigated in a unified national and European context. The candidate will also provide students with assistance in drafting undergraduate final dissertations, master's and doctoral theses in the above-mentioned courses, and will perform tutoring activities.

Research activities: The candidate is required to demonstrate continuity in the research activity, also in order to obtain relevant results in the forthcoming assessment of the quality of research of the Department of Economics. The Professor may be required to prepare and submit projects aimed at obtaining competitive funding, as well as an active and proactive role in the implementation of departmental projects aimed at acquiring external resources.

Administrative tasks: the candidate will be required to undertake tasks and responsibilities of guidance and coordination within the degree courses of the Department and/or tasks supporting the activities of the Department of Economics.
