Qualitative standards and further qualifying elements: Senior experience of high quality research and teaching according to international standards in areas of the academic disciplinary sector M-GGR/02 ECONOMIC-POLITICAL GEOGRAPHY are required, with a special focus on political geography and geopolitics, from a history of science perspective, and history of geographical thought in particular. Further qualifying elements will be regional and urban geography, and marginal areas, also with the use of digital cartography and G.I.S., as well as the participation to international and national academic research networks, national and international conferences, as well as third mission activities.

Teaching duties: The candidate will teach high profile courses in the areas of the academic discipline M-GGR/02 ECONOMIC-POLITICAL GEOGRAPHY in the first, second, and Ph. D degree programs of the Department of Economics of the University of Molise and, subordinately, of other Departments of the University, with particular reference to the areas of political geography and geopolitics, globalization and sustainable development, with a historical-geographical approach, also in English. Furthermore, she/he will give assistance to students for the preparation of their first and second degree's final essay, and Ph. D dissertations, within the same courses. She/he will carry out student assistance services including guidance and tutoring activities.

Research duties: The candidate will carry out high profile research activities according to international standards to contribute to the international projection of the Department of Economics, to obtain a relevant position in the next VQR evaluation, promote lines of research pertaining to the following departmental research areas: historical, sociological and political sciences, agricultural areas and sustainable development, and of the "Aree interne". The candidate will be asked to prepare and submit projects aimed at obtaining competitive grants and to have an active and propositional role in the development of departmental projects aimed at acquiring external financial resources for the Department of Economics.

Administrative duties: The candidate will perform administrative duties and take direction and coordination responsibilities within the study courses of the Department of Economics.
