Selection procedure for recruiting a university Full Professor, in accordance with article 18, paragraph 4 Law 240/2010, in the competition sector 11/E1 GENERAL PSYCHOLOGY, PSYCHOBIOLOGY AND PHYSIOLOGICAL PSYCHOLOGY, PSYCHOMETRY, Scientific Disciplinary Sector M-PSI/01 GENERAL PSYCHOLOGY.

Specific functions the candidate will have to carry out, teaching and scientific commitments:

Teaching activities

The candidate must be able to carry out teaching activities in the competition sector 11/E1 GENERAL PSYCHOLOGY, PSYCHOBIOLOGY AND PHYSIOLOGICAL PSYCHOLOGY, PSYCHOMETRY, and in particular in the Scientific Disciplinary Sector M-PSI/01 GENERAL PSYCHOLOGY. The didactic commitment will be carried out in the degree courses offered by the Department of Humanities, Social Sciences and Education (SUSeF) and will have to ensure the coverage of the courses envisaged by the study plans in which M-PSI/01 GENERAL PSYCHOLOGY is present, with particular reference to the training on cognitive psychology, methods of study and intervention in general psychology including also cognitive neuroscience methods, the relationship between neuroscience and general psychology. The teaching commitment also includes tutoring, assistance to students in drafting papers for the final exam of single-cycle, three-year and master's courses.

Research activities

The candidate must be able to carry out research activities in the competition sector 11/E1 GENERAL PSYCHOLOGY, PSYCHOBIOLOGY AND PHYSIOLOGICAL PSYCHOLOGY, PSYCHOMETRY, and in particular in the Scientific Disciplinary Sector M-PSI/01 GENERAL PSYCHOLOGY. The scientific commitment required will concern cognitive psychology and the development of cognitive models with specific reference to the systems of spatial navigation and topographical orientation in humans, also investigated with the application of advanced functional neuroimaging techniques. The candidate will have to demonstrate continuity in research, also in order to obtain significant results in the next VQR evaluations of the Department of Humanities, Social Sciences and Education. The professor may be required to prepare and submit projects aimed at obtaining competitive funding, as well as an active and proactive role in the implementation of departmental projects aimed at acquiring external resources.

Nationally recognised quality standards and any additional elements of scientific qualifications

High-profile teaching and research activities are required in the competition sector 11/E1 GENERAL PSYCHOLOGY, PSYCHOBIOLOGY AND PHYSIOLOGICAL PSYCHOLOGY, PSYCHOMETRY, and in particular in the Scientific Disciplinary Sector M-PSI/01 GENERAL PSYCHOLOGY, the results of which have been published in internationally recognized journals, subject to peer review and indexed in the main bibliometric databases (Scopus, JCR).
